

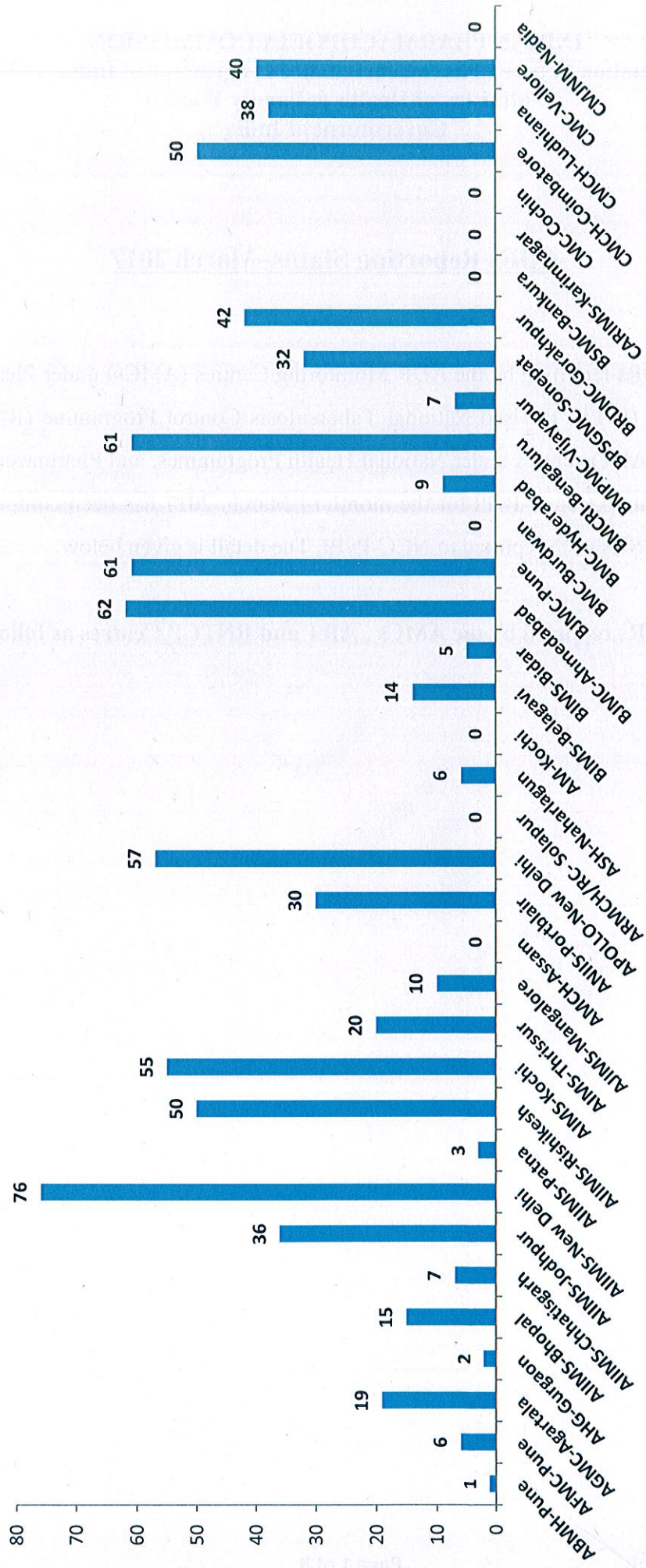

ADRs Reporting Status–March 2017

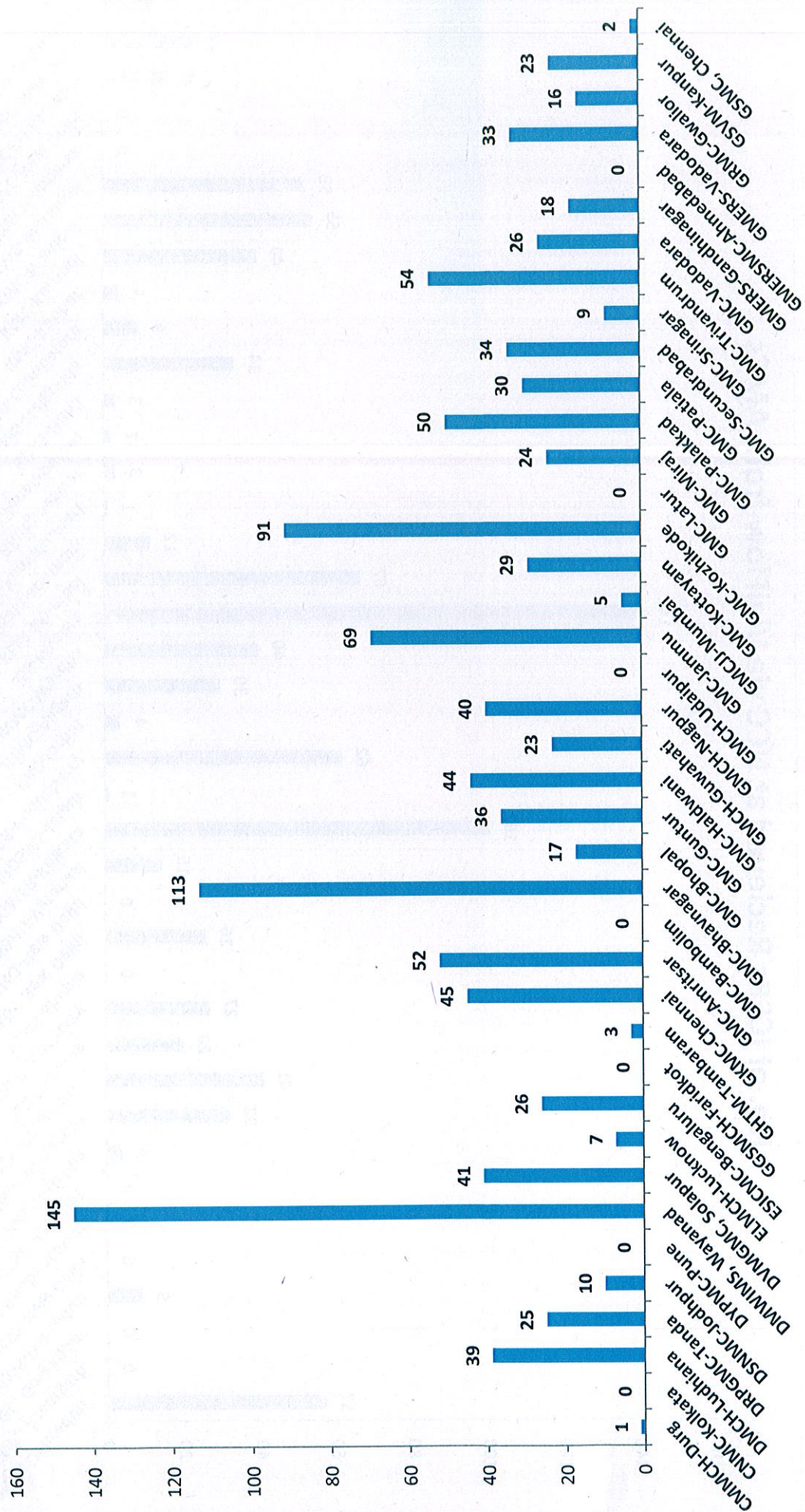
The spontaneous ADRs reporting by the ADR Monitoring Centres (AMCs) under Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI), Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme (RNTCP) & Anti-Retroviral Therapy (ART) centres under National Health Programmes, and Pharmaceutical industries to National Coordination Centre-PvPI for the month of March, 2017 has been compiled. During the month total **6320 ICSRs** were reported to NCC-PvPI. The detail is given below.

(I) Spontaneous ADRs reported by the AMCs , ART and RNTCP Centres as follows

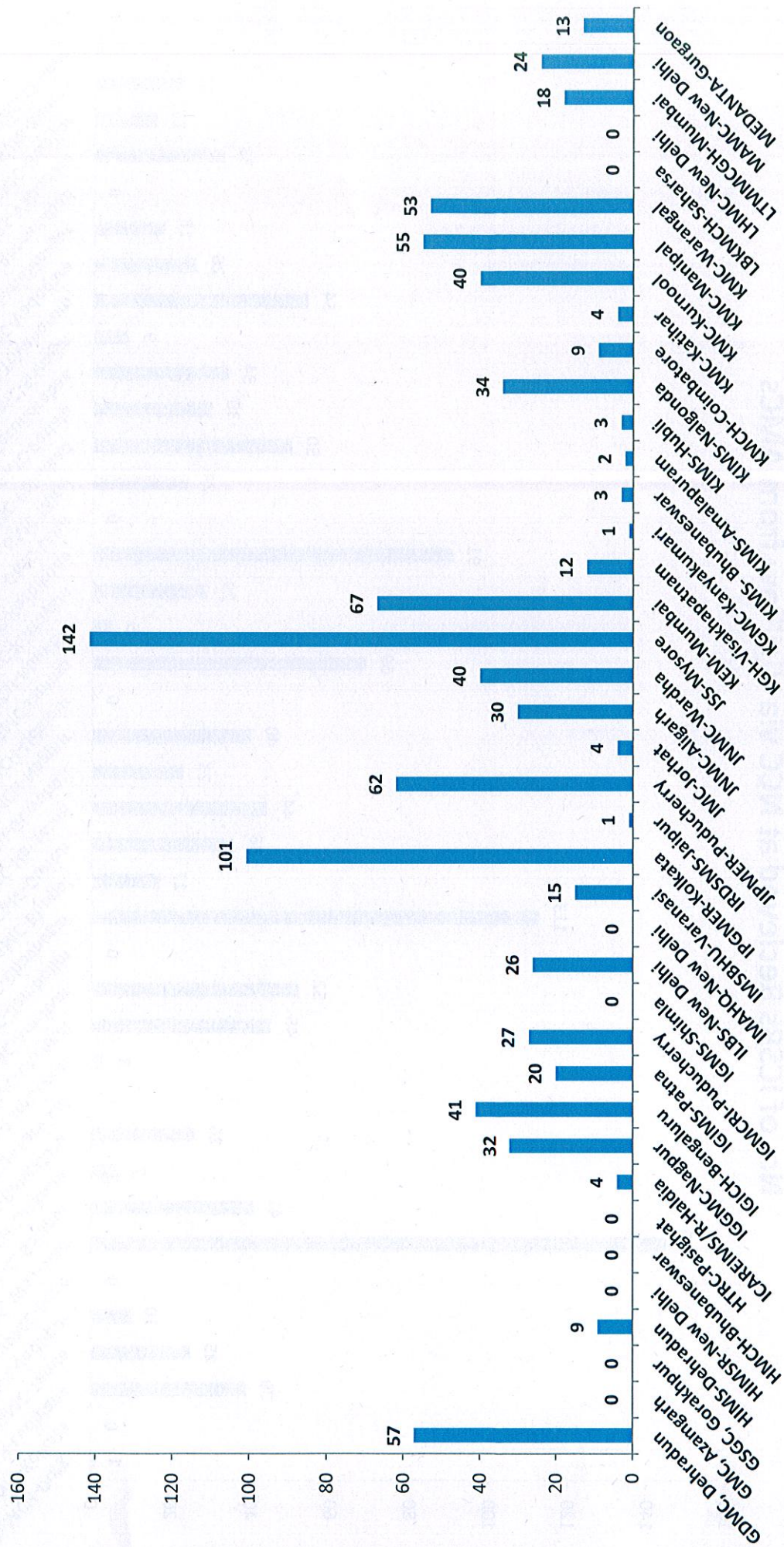
No. of ICSRs Recieved at NCC via VigiFlow from AMCs



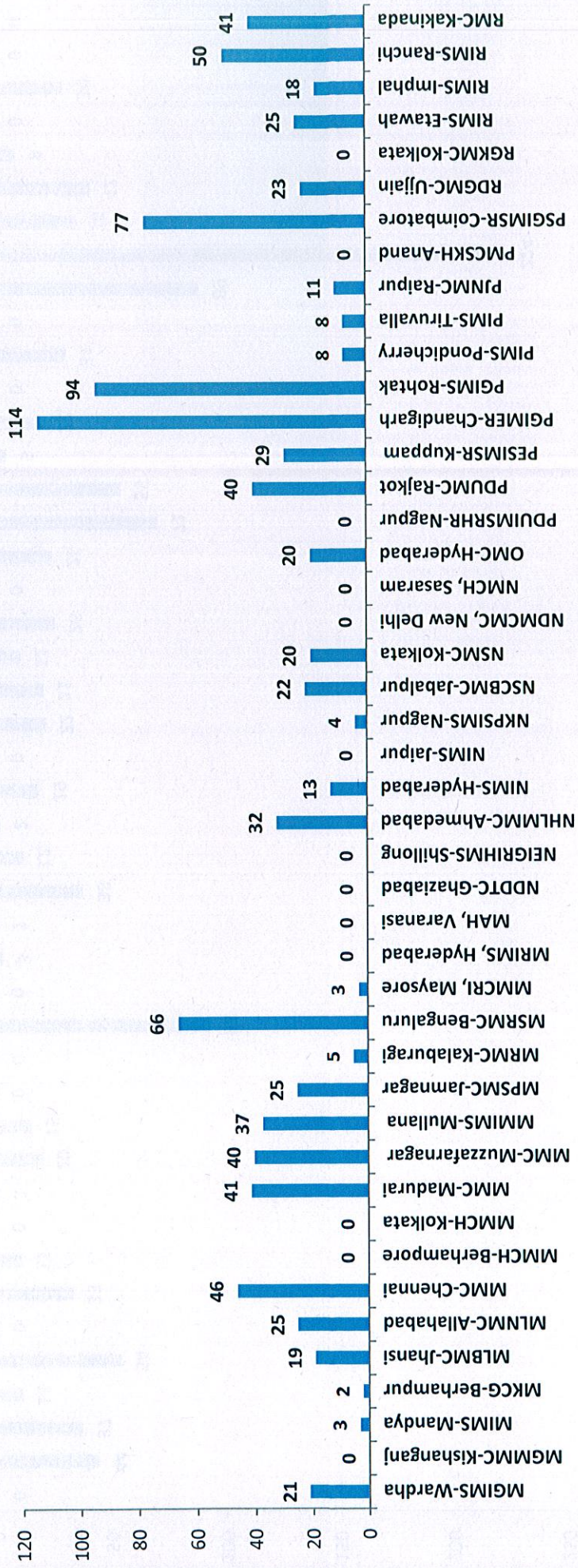
No. of ICSRs Recieved at NCC via VigiFlow from AMCs



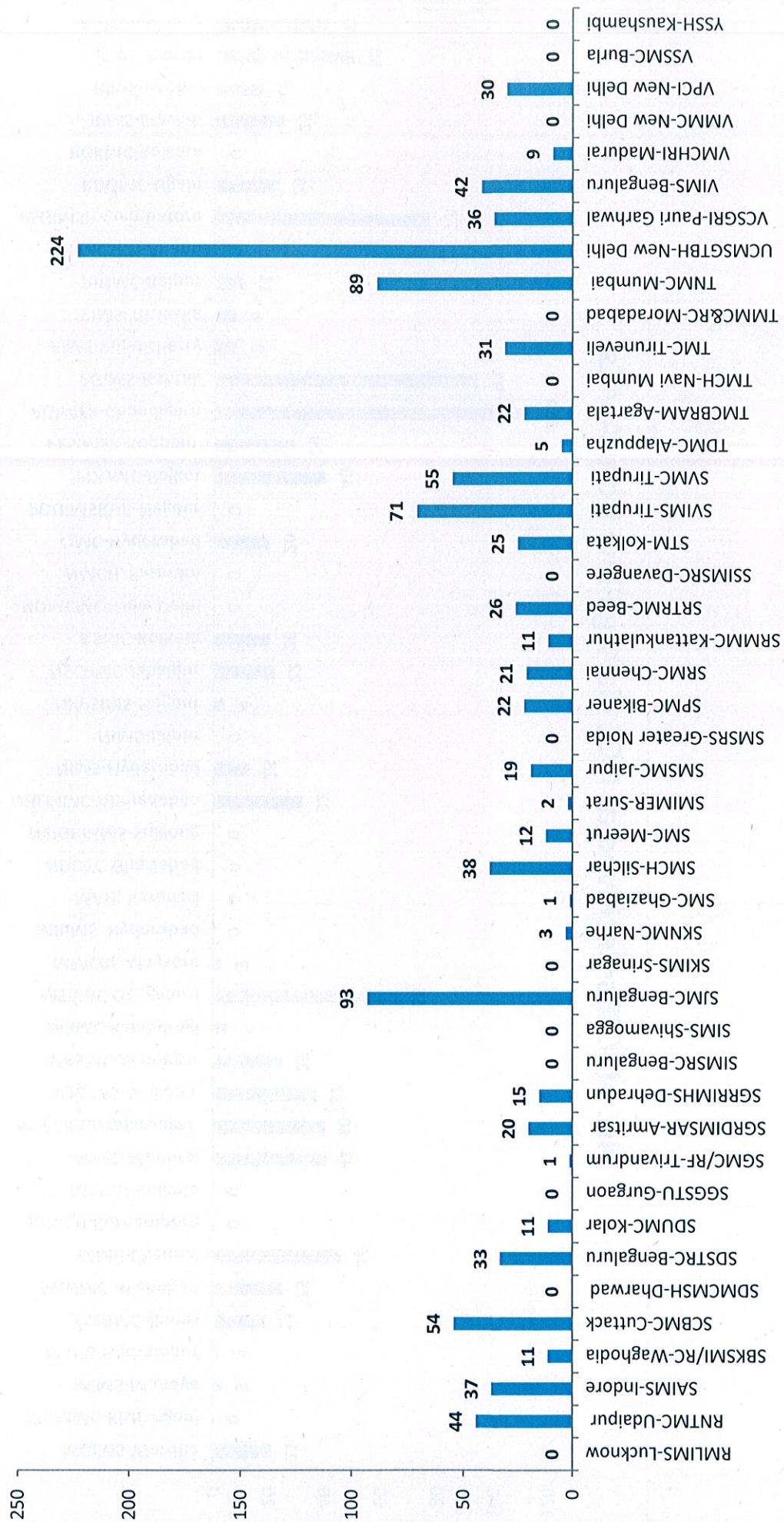
