The preliminary analysis of ICSRs available in PvPI database reveals that the following drugs may be associated with the risks as given below.

Sl. No	Suspected Drugs	Indication	Adverse Reaction(s)
1	Clindamycin	Respiratory Tract Infections, penicillin resistant staphylococcal infections and many anaerobes such as bacteroides, skin, soft tissue and dental infections	Acute Generalised Exanthematous Pustulosis (AGEP)
2	Triamcinolone	Corticosteroid	Skin Peeling
3	Polymyxin B	Other Antibiotic	Mottled Skin
4	Diclofenac	Acute musculo-skeletal pain; arthritis; gout; spondylitis; migraine; post-operative pain	Nicolau Syndrome
