1	Acetazolamide	Adjunct in treatment of chronic open-angle glaucoma; secondary glaucoma; as a part of pre-operative treatment of acute angle-closure glaucoma	Drug Hypersensitivity Syndrome
2	Linagliptin	Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus	Acute Generalised Exanthematous Pustulosis (AGEP)
3	Diloxanide	Amoebiasis	Glossitis
