Advisory for Reporting Adverse Events/Adverse Drug Reactions due to use of Hydroxychloroquine as prophylaxis for SARS-CoV-2 infection (COVID-19)

As per Recommendation of empiric use of Hydroxychloroquine for prophylaxis of SARS-CoV-2 infection uploaded on the website of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India (https://www.mohfw.gov.in/)
One of the key considerations is that:

The Prophylactic use of Hydroxy-chloroquine to be coupled with the Pharmacovigilance for the adverse drug reactions through the self reporting using the Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI) Helpline/App.

As the nation, is facing a huge challenge to fight against the COVID-19 from spreading across the communities, therefore during the prophylactic use of hydroxychloroquine if any adverse event is encountered by the patients, such adverse events may be reported by the Patients themselves or by the Health Care Professionals on the following
