S. No.	Suspected Drugs	Indication(s)	Adverse Drug Reactions
1	Amphotericin B	 Treatment of Febrile Neutropenia in cancer patients. Treatment for invasive fungal infection in patients, who are refractory to or intolerant of conventional Amphotericin B therapy. Indicated for the treatment of Visceral Leishmaniasis. 	Hyperkalaemia
2	Carbimazole	Indicated for the treatment of thyrotoxicosis including thyrotoxicosis crisis.	Agranulocytosis
