Memorandum of Understanding

The Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission with the British Pharmacopoeia Commission

Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC) has signed a MoU with the British Pharmacopoeia Commission on 18th February 2021. Through this MOU both the parties, recognize the importance of developing close cooperation and exchange of information in the field of regulation of medicines with special reference to pharmacopoeial standards in accordance with their respective laws and regulations. Both the organizations explore opportunities for technical cooperation in areas of mutual benefit in the development of monographs and future technologies, will consider adopting harmonizing standards, exchanging information on quality of medicines and sharing technical expertise on the development of monographs and test methods. The areas of co-operation will be broad and cover development of standards for active pharmaceutical ingredients as well as finished products. This partnership will also support exchanges of technical and scientific expertise, skill development in the subject area for the benefit of public health.
